O R D E R

MacLay Rancho Water Company, a public utility heretofore engaged in the business of selling and distributing water for domestic, irrigation and other purposes to residents of the Town of Pacoima, Los Angeles County, California, having applied for authority to discontinue further public utility water service by reason of the fact that the Bureau of Water and Power of the City of Los Angeles has completely paralleled all of its water mains in the territory above mentioned and on or about March 1, 1938, acquired all of the consumers formerly served by applicant herein and by reason of the further fact that MacLay Rancho Water Company has not served any consumers with water since March 1, 1938, and, after investigation, it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that MacLay Rancho Water Company be and it is hereby authorized to discontinue all further public utility water service in and in the vicinity of Pacoima, Los

Angeles County, on and after the thirtieth day of June, 1938, and thereafter be relieved of all further public utility obligations and liabilities in connection with said water works and appurtenant facilities.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
