

Decision No. 31009

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of the application of PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY for an order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California approving a certain agreement entered into by and between applicant and PACIFIC UNION COLLEGE, INC., dated January 7, 1938.

O R D E R

This is an application of the Pacific Gas and Electric Company for an order authorizing Applicant Company to enter into a proposed written agreement with Pacific Union College, Inc., and hereinafter sometimes referred to as Customer. A copy of this agreement is attached to and made a part of the application as Exhibit "A."

Under the terms and conditions set forth in said agreement Applicant Company, among other things, agrees to sell and deliver to Customer and the latter has agreed to purchase from the former all the electric energy which shall be required for the operation of Customer's electrical machinery and apparatus and in the conduct of Customer's business upon its premises situated at Angwin, in the County of Napa, State of California. Some of the more important provisions of said agreement may be enumerated thus.

The electric energy to be delivered and received shall be what is commonly designated as single phase, 120 volt, and three phase, 240 volt, sixty cycle, alternating current and shall be delivered and metered through one master meter located at a convenient place not more than a distance of one span from the company's existing electric distribution line.

The rates and charges to be paid by Customer are set forth as follows:

Fixed Charges	\$165.00 per month, plus
Energy Charge	1.0¢ per Kw-hr.

The term of the agreement is for a period of two and one-half years from and after the date at which service is first rendered hereunder.

The proposed agreement also contains a statement that it shall at all times be subject to such changes and/or modifications as the Commission may make in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

Inasmuch as both parties to the proposed agreement are desirous of entering into the same and the Commission is of the opinion that the performance of the covenants thereof will not constitute a burden to Applicant's other customers and that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary and good cause appearing therefor:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Pacific Union College, Inc., in terms as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached to the application, covering the sale of electric energy at the rates and under the conditions therein provided.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company shall file a copy of said agreement with the Commission within thirty (30) days after its execution.

Authority herein granted shall become effective on

the date hereof.
