Addie L. Stafford, O. R. Powell and J. M. Hampton, Jr., applicants herein, are co-partners doing business under the firm name and style of Live Oak Warehouses.

It appears from the application that Addie L. Stafford has arranged to sell and transfer her one-third interest in said business and properties to the other two co-partners for the sum of \$7,450.00 payable \$3,950.00 in cash and \$3,500.00 by a one year four per cent note. The Commission accordingly has been asked to authorize the transfer.

The Commission, having considered applicants' request, is of the opinion that a hearing on such request is not necessary, and that this application should be granted, as herein provided, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Addie L. Stafford be, and she hereby is authorized to sell and transfer to O. R. Powell and J. M. Hampton, Jr. her one-third interest in the business and properties of the Live Oak Warehouses, provided,

1. That applicants shall join in common supplement to the tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates for storage in the Live Oak Warehouses, applicants Addie L. Stafford, O. R. Powell and J. M. Hampton, Jr., co-partners,

on the one hand withdrawing from, and applicants O. R. Powell and J. M. Hampton, Jr., co-partners, on the other hand adopting said tariffs and all effective supplements thereto, and

2. That the authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
