O R D E R

In this application Southern Pacific Company seeks authority to abandon its non-agency station of Gato, County of Santa Barbara. In the application it is alleged that there has been no freight business transacted at this non-agency station for more than two years.

The nearest agencies to Gato are Gaviota 9.6 miles east and Concepcion, 4.5 miles west.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company is granted authority to abandon its non-agency station of Gato, Santa Barbara County, to eliminate said name from its station records, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
