ORIGINAL

An industrial drill track was constructed in 1905 and 1906 to serve certain industries in the vicinity of 37th and Alameda Streets, in the City of Vernon. For several years past service has been suspended over this track, due to the fact that operation thereover has been rendered hazardous because of excavations by the Consolidated Rock Products Company.

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon and remove its drill track extending from a connection with its San Pedro branch at 37th and Alameda Streets, in the City of Vernon, as more particularly described in the application and as shown in yellow on Exhibit "A," attached to the application. Within thirty days after abandonment and removal, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
