SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

ORIGINAL

Good Cause Appearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (4) of Decision
No. 30557, dated January 24th, 1938, in this proceeding, is hereby
amended to read as follows:

- (4) One flashing light wigwag signal, of a type approved
by this Commission, shall be installed for the protec-
tion of northbound traffic on the Arroyo Seco Parkway,
substantially at the location as shown in red on the
map (Drawing B-1552), attached to the application.
One Standard No. 1 crossing sign shall be installed
for the protection of southbound traffic on Broadway
crossing the interchange track between Southern Paci-
fic Company and The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe
Railway Company.

In all other respects, Decision No. 30557 shall remain in
full force and effect.
