O R D E R

It appears from the above application that applicant will inaugurate passenger stage service in accordance with the provisions of Decision No. 30876, dated May 23, 1938, (Application No. 21400), serving the territory and stations now served by mixed trains Nos. 3 and 4; and that the operation of said trains will no longer be necessary for the transportation of passengers.

Good Cause Appearing, Sierra Railroad Company is authorized to discontinue local passenger service on its trains Nos. 3 and 4 and to discontinue all passenger service between Oakdale and Tuolumne, except special passenger train service; and to cancel tariffs and time schedules on not less than one day's notice to this Commission and the public. Said passenger train service shall be abandoned concurrently with the establishment of passenger stage service as authorized in Decision No. 30876. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
