FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Applicant requests in writing that it be granted permission to abandon its agency at Windsor, Sonoma County, which is now being operated on a seasonal basis as authorized in Decision No. 25307, dated October 31st, 1932, for approximately two months each year. Applicant alleges that there is insufficient business offered to continue the seasonal agency and that principal shippers offer no objection to the proposal. It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the request should be granted.

Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its agency at Windsor, Sonoma County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly provided not less than ten days' notice is given the public by posting notice at said station. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall become effective immediately.
