O P I N I O N

By this application Vinita A. Jones, an individual operating under the name and style of Marysville - Nevada City Auto Stage, as an automotive common carrier of passengers and express between Nevada City and Marysville requests an amendment to her certificate of public convenience and necessity which will eliminate therefrom the present 200 pound weight limit condition now in effect on single shipments of express and substitute in lieu thereof a condition which will provide weight limit of 100 pounds per single shipment on express to be transported.

Applicant alleges that practically all express shipments tendered to her are in small quantities and consist principally of meat, bread and produce and that during 1937 only one shipment over 100 pounds was transported. It is further alleged that applicant is not now financially able to provide equipment to handle large shipments and present equipment cannot handle property in excess of 100 pounds.

We do not believe that the public interest will be adversely affected by the amendment proposed nor do we believe that this is a matter in which a public hearing is necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to E. A. Jones, deceased, and which certificate was transferred by operation of law through an order of the Superior Court to his widow, Vinita A. Jones, operating under the name and style of Marysville - Nevada City Auto Stage, be and it is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following weight restriction in lieu of the existing weight restriction now imposed.

In the transportation of express no single shipment in excess of 100 pounds shall be accepted for transportation and all express matter transported shall be carried on passenger vehicles.

In all other respects the operative rights of applicant shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
