O P I N I O N

By this application Pacific Greyhound Lines, a passenger stage corporation, seeks authority to change its route within the city of Davis.

Applicant alleges as justification for the authority sought herein that the proposed rerouting will provide a more direct route through the city of Davis, eliminate traffic hazards, and it has the approval of the Chief of Police of the City of Davis, as expressed in his letter of June 30, 1938, a copy, marked Exhibit A, is attached to the application herein and made a part thereof.

The proposed route sought to be amended was created by Decision No. 23244, on Application No. 16989.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Pacific Greyhound Lines be, and it is, hereby authorized to change its route within the city of Davis as authorized in Decision No. 23244, on Application No. 16989, by amending paragraph ten, on page 18, of the above decision to read as follows:

EASTBOUND: Entering the city of Davis via State Route No. 6 to "B" Street, thence to 2nd Street, thence to "C" Street, thence to 1st Street, thence to State Route No. 6, or via "B" Street direct to 1st Street.

WESTBOUND: Via State Route No. 6 to "E" Street, thence to 2nd Street, thence to "G" Street, thence to 1st Street, thence to "B" Street, thence to State Route No. 6, or direct via 1st Street to "B" Street.

In all other respects save for the specific authority herein granted Decision No. 23244, on Application No. 16989, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
