O P I N I O N

By this application Pacific Greyhound Lines, a passenger stage corporation, seeks authority to abandon that portion of its service as an automotive carrier of passengers, baggage and express, between Greenville School and Mountain House, via Altamont, and to reroute this service over the new highway now under construction between the above referred to termini.

The portion of the route proposed to be abandoned was created by Decision No. 23244, on Application No. 16989, as amended by Decision No. 25815, on Application No. 18784.

In justification for the abandonment sought herein applicant alleges that service to and from Altamont is not warranted as evidenced by Exhibit B attached to the application herein, showing a tabulation of passengers carried during the month of May, 1938, to and from Altamont. The tabulation shows that on nineteen eastbound schedules, thirty-five passengers were carried to and from Altamont, and that on twenty westbound schedules, twenty-eight passengers were carried to and from the above-named point.

Applicant, in seeking authority to reroute its service over the new highway now under construction between Greenville School and Mountain House, states that said rerouting will expedite operation and provide a better service to the public moving between San Joaquin Valley points and the Bay area.

In view of the foregoing circumstances this appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines be and it is hereby authorized to abandon that portion of its route between Greenville School and Mountain House via Altamont as authorized in Decision No. 23244, on Application No. 16989, and amended by Decision No. 25815, on Application No. 18784.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Greyhound Lines be and it is hereby authorized to reroute its service over the new highway now under construction between Greenville School and Mountain House in lieu of the route herein authorized to be abandoned, subject to the following conditions:

Applicant shall file and make effective on ten (10) days' notice to the Commission and the public a time schedule in accordance with the authority herein granted.

In all other respects save for the authority herein granted, Decision No. 23244, on Application No. 16989, as amended by Decision No. 25815, on Application No. 18784, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
