SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 29868 of June 14, 1937, in this proceeding, applicant was authorized to transport goods, wares and merchandise under contract with the Collector of Customs of the Treasury Department of the United States Government, between points in the City and County of San Francisco, for a period of six months ending December 13, 1937 at the rate of twenty seven-cents (27ϕ) per package. Thereafter, relying upon the conditions set forth in justification of the original request, applicant filed a supplemental petition on January 13, 1938 seeking similar authority for a further period of at least six months. The further authority sought was granted by Decision No. 30579 of January 31, 1938, for a period terminating July 30, 1938.

By supplemental application filed July 15, 1938, applicant seeks to assess a rate of twenty-nine cents (29¢) per package for this transportation service and to have the period of its effectiveness apply for not less than one year. In support of this request, applicant relies upon substantially the same conditions upon which the original and supplemental applications were granted. However, it alleges that increased drayage costs require an increase of the rate to twenty-nine cents (29¢) per package and, moreover, that the Treasury Department now insists the contract be executed for a period of one year. It appears from said supplemental application that said proposed rate is reasonable in that it will not constitute any unreasonable or unjust discrimination against other shippers and traffic. It further appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the relief sought should be authorized.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said supplemental application be and it is hereby granted.

The authority granted shall expire one (1) year from the date hereof unless extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
