O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct a State Highway Route 4 (Daly Street) at separated grades over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location as shown by the map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-482.6-A. Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by the Southern Pacific Railroad Company. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended) or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
