O R D E R

Visalia Electric Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across 2nd Avenue and "D" Avenue at Calcite Station, Tulare County, at the location described in the application. The crossing of 2nd Avenue shall be identified as No. 77B-13.6-C, and that of "D" Avenue shall be identified as Crossing No. 77B-13.8-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding 4 per cent. Protection at each crossing shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O. No. 75-A).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
