BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, having filed an application with the Railroad Commission of the State of California requesting approval of a certain agreement entered into by and between Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, and Henry Houx, an irrigator, in words and figures as set forth in the copy of the agreement marked Exhibit "A" of Exhibit No. 1 and attached to the application herein, said agreement providing, among other things, for the sale and delivery to Henry Houx, as an accommodation and without dedication of same to public use, of such quantity of excess water flowing in Pacific Gas and Electric Company's East Side Pipe Line not exceeding a flow of six miner's inches⁽¹⁾ as said Henry Houx shall require for irrigation purposes on a certain parcel of land located in the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of

1. A miner's inch for the purposes of this proceeding shall mean a continuous flow of water equivalent to 1.5 cubic feet per minute.

the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 9, Township 11 North, Range 7 East, M.D.B. & M., in Placer County, said water to be paid for at the rate of sixteen cents (16¢) per miner's inch day⁽²⁾, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for the sale and delivery of excess water to Henry Four under substantially the same terms and conditions as are set forth in the form of agreement marked Exhibit "A" of Exhibit No. 1 which is attached to the application herein and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, a corporation, file with this Commission, within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order, two certified copies of said agreement as finally consummated.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
