ORIGINAL

In this application the City of Oakland requests permission to install at the east line of Fallon Street, between the east and west bound tracks of Southern Pacific Company's Seventh Street line, City of Oakland, a vertical three-unit red reflector signal (California Automobile Association No. W22R), for the purpose of warning motorists proceeding easterly on said Seventh Street to make the turn instead of running on to the open track east of Fallon Street.

It appears that the request is reasonable and should be granted, therefore,

The City of Oakland is hereby authorized to install a vertical three-unit red reflector signal (California Automobile Association No. W22R), at the east line of Fallon Street, between the east and west bound tracks of Southern Pacific Company's Seventh Street line, Oakland. Said sign shall not extend more than thirty (30) inches above the top of rail.

Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so notify this Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
