O R D E R

It appears from the above application that the real property proposed to be conveyed to the City of Los Angeles and the property being optioned to the City of Los Angeles, as described in detail in the copy of agreement (Exhibit "A") attached to the application, is no longer required for railroad purposes, and that the agreement should be approved, therefore

Southern Pacific Railroad Company, Southern Pacific Company and Pacific Electric Railway Company are authorized to convey to the City of Los Angeles certain parcels of land at the harbor of Los Angeles, and are authorized to option to said City of Los Angeles certain other parcels of land at said harbor, in accordance with the terms and as described in the agreement dated July 1, 1938, attached to and made a part of the application (Exhibit "A").

Within thirty days after completion of property transfer, applicants shall so notify the Commission, in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended). This order shall become effective immediately.
