O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct at grade State Highway (Road VI-Fre-4-Sel) across a spur track of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Selma, Fresno County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. E-221.05-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 3 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O.72.

Applicant is authorized to remove existing wigwag and deraill from crossing, and substitute therefor two reflectorized No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. 75-A) and adequately floodlight the crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
