ORDER STAYING DECISION

Decision No. 31185 ordered Valley Express Co. to cancel rates as an express corporation between certain points and to desist operating as an express corporation between those points. Rehearing was denied and Valley Express Co. has petitioned for an order staying the effectiveness of the desist order. It is alleged that petitioner is preparing an application to the Supreme Court for a writ of review, and that great and irreparable injury will result to petitioner if it is required to suspend operations pending judicial review.

Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 31185 is hereby stayed and suspended until October 10, 1938, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.
