O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct State highway designated as Road VI-Ker-141-Bak. at separated grades over the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at Oak Street in the City of Bakersfield, Kern County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-888.5-A. Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. (Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G. O. 26-C.) Crossing No. 2-888.5 at the site of authorized grade separation shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years, unless time be extended, or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
