THIRTEENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By petitions filed September 19, 1938, the Draymen's Association of San Francisco, Walkup Drayage and Warehouse Company, Western Sugar Refinery and California-Hawaiian Sugar Refining Corporation, Ltd., seek an order modifying Decision No. 28632, as amended, in Case No. 4084, by providing a changed basis of rates for the transportation of sugar within the San Francisco drayage area. Petitioners ask that a rate of 12½ cents per 100 pounds, minimum charge 40 cents be established as minimum for the transportation of this commodity in shipments of all sizes from refineries or from refiners' or manufacturers' stocks in San Francisco to retailers and consumers within the San Francisco drayage area, and that such rate be made to supersede the present zone class and commodity rates. It is represented that a change in the method of distribution brought about by a strike condition existing in San Francisco which necessitates the establishment of the rates sought.

Upon consideration of the facts and circumstances shown and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Appendix "A" of Decision No. 28632, as amended, in Case No. 4084 be and it is hereby further amended by adding the following new item to page 24 thereof:

116	Sugar, when moving from refineries, or from refiners' or manufacturers' stocks to retailers or consumers	12½ cents per 100 pounds Minimum charge 40 cents per shipment

In all other respects said Decision No. 28632, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
