TENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By petitions filed September 19, 1938, the Draymen's Association of Alameda County, Western Sugar Refinery and California-Hawaiian Sugar Refining Corporation, Itd., seek an order modifying Decision No. 29217, as amended, in Cases Nos. 4108 and 4109, by providing a changed basis of rates for the transportation of sugar within the East Bay drayage area. Petitioners ask that a rate of 13-3/4 cents per 100 pounds, minimum charge 40 cents, be established as minimum for the transportation of sugar in shipments of all sizes, from pool cars in

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the East Bay drayage area to retailers and consumers within that area, this rate to supersede, temporarily, the present zone class rate basis.

It is represented that a change in the method of distribution, brought about by a strike condition existing in Alameda County, necessitates the establishment of the basis sought.

Upon consideration of the circumstances and conditions shown, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ONDERED that Appendix "A" of Decision No. 29217, as amended, in the above entitled proceedings, be and it is hereby further amended by adding the following new special commodity rate to Section 3 on page 24 thereof:

Sugar, when moving from pool cars for distribution to retailers or consumers 13-3/4 cents per 100 pounds, Minimum charge 40 cents per shipment

In all other respects, said Decision No. 29217, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
