O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Railroad Avenue (an unimproved and unused street) in Daly City (Union Park Station), San Mateo County, at the location described in the application. This order is made on the express condition that Railroad Avenue is not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing and that this order shall not be deemed an authorization for the construction of an opening of said street to public use and travel across said spur track. Said track shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding four per cent will be feasible in the event that the construction of an opening of Railroad Avenue across said track shall be hereafter authorized and so that said grade crossing may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
