BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of 3 lead tracks, and the shifting of 3 existing lead tracks across roadway.

BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 13735 in the above entitled application Southern Pacific Company was authorized to construct certain tracks at grade over public road in the town of Newcastle, Placer County, and was required under condition 3 of the Order to maintain a human flagman at said crossings during certain prescribed hours. The hours of this flagman were subsequently changed by supplemental order and Southern Pacific Company now requests a further modification.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Condition (3) of Decision 13735 in the above entitled application be modified to read as follows:

- (3) A human flagman shall be maintained for the protection of said crossings for a period of ten hours daily during the period from approximately July 1st to October 1st of each year, providing that Southern Pacific Company shall file with the Commission prior to July 1st of each year a statement showing the hours during which it proposes to maintain said human flagman.

In all other respects the Commission's Decision 13735 shall remain in full force and effect.
