O P I N I O N

By this application Security Van & Storage Company, Inc. seeks authority to discontinue service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of ranch supplies to and from Malibu Ranch as authorized in Decision No. 15085 dated June 22, 1925 on Application No. 10481.

In justification for the authority sought herein applicant alleges that there has been no movement of ranch supplies to Malibu Ranch for the past several years and applicant is now preparing a reissue of its present tariff and does not wish to be burdened with the necessity of publishing extensive rates from all points in Southern California to the ranch for which there has been no movement of freight; also, in order to publish a specific list of commodities under the term "ranch supplies" would be a tremendous task in addition to being a financial burden.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Security Van & Storage Company, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to abandon its service as a common carrier for the transportation of ranch supplies to and from Malibu Ranch as authorized in Decision 15085,

dated June 22, 1925 on Application No. 10481, providing that applicant shall file a supplement to his tariff and a time schedule showing the abandonment of service as herein authorized.

In all other respects Decision 15085, on Application No. 10481 shall remain in full force and effect save for the authority herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
