

highway common carrier and highway contract carrier, seeks authority to transport household goods and professional books for the United States Government from Rockwell Air Depot (North Island), Coronado and points in the San Diego metropolitan area to points in the metropolitan area of Sacramento, including the Sacramento Airport, under contract with the U.S. Quartermaster, Fort Rosecrans, Point Loma, at charges less than those which would accrue under minimum rates established by Decision No. 29891 of June 28, 1937, as amended, in Cases Nos. 4086 and 4099 (40 C.R.C. 533).

The matter was submitted at public hearings had before Examiner Bryant at Los Angeles on September 27 and 28, 1938. During these hearings evidence was introduced relative to the nature of the proposed operation and to applicant's estimated costs thereunder. It developed, however, that the U.S. Quartermaster had, subsequent to the filing of this application, contracted with a carrier other than applicant for performance of the transportation service here involved. This application has, therefore, become moot and should be dismissed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby dismissed.
