OPINION AND ORDER

In this application W. L. Mobley asks the Railroad Commission for authority to sell his telephone line known as the "North Bloomfield Telephone Company line" and W. H. Taylor asks permission to purchase the same for the sum of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

This property consists of a telephone line extending from Nevada City to North Bloomfield, and seven telephones.

The Commission has given consideration to the request of the applicants and is of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required, and that the application should be granted subject to the conditions incorporated in this Opinion and Order, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that W. L. Mobley be, and he hereby is authorized to sell and transfer on or before January 1, 1939, the aforementioned telephone properties and such operative rights as may pertain thereto, to W. H. Taylor who is hereby authorized to acquire and operate the same at present rates.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that W. L. Mobley shall, concurrently with the date of the sale of the aforesaid properties to W. H. Taylor, discontinue all his public utility telephone operations.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days after the transfer of the properties herein described W. H. Taylor shall file with the Railroad Commission a certified copy of the bill of sale under which he acquires and holds title to said properties.

The effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
