O R D E R

It appears from the above application that insufficient passenger business has been transacted at applicant's station of Keeler, Inyo County, during the past three years to justify continued maintenance of passenger agency service at said station.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its passenger agency at the station of Keeler, located on its Mina Branch of its Salt Lake Division in Inyo County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly.

Within thirty (30) days after discontinuance of said passenger agency, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
