

Decision No. 31336

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the matter of the Investigation, on the Commission's own motion, into the operations, rates, charges, classifications, rules, regulations, contracts and practices, or any thereof, of FLORENCE SEDAN SERVICE, INCORPORATED, a corporation, respondent, operating as a "passenger stage corporation," as defined in Section 2-1/4, Public Utilities Act, for the purpose of (a) determining whether said respondent is engaged in conducting any service as such "passenger stage corporation," between any points in this State and more particularly between Los Angeles and San Francisco, and intermediate points, without having first obtained a certificate of public convenience and necessity or without any prior right therefor; and (b) determining whether said respondent should be ordered to cease and desist conducting services as such a "passenger stage corporation," in the State of California, and particularly between San Francisco, Los Angeles and intermediate points, unless and until it shall have first obtained a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
