ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this complaint reparation and rates for the future are sought in connection with the transportation of sheep in single and double deck cars from points on the lines of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company to San Francisco, South San Francisco and Los Angeles. At the written request of complainants, the matter was held in abeyance pending the issuance of a decision by the Commission in Case No. 3846, Sevier Commission Company et al.

vs. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company et al. The latter proceeding was disposed of by Decision No. 50480 dated January 5, 1958, the reparation award therein sought being denied as to movements similar to those involved in this complaint. Thereafter, on February 11, 1958, June 27, 1958, and September 19, 1958, letters were addressed to complainants requesting them to advise what action they desired to have taken in connection with this complaint. No reply to any of these letters having been received, it appears that complainants do not now desire to prosecute this complaint and it will therefore be dismissed. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled complaint be and it is hereby dismissed.
