SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By supplemental application Lassen National Park Company, a corporation, formerly known as Lassen National Park Camp, Ltd. operating as a common carrier for the automotive transportation of passengers, baggage and express between Redding and the western gateway of Lassen Volcanic National Park seeks an order of the Commission reducing its present operations between the above points from a year-round service to a seasonal service between the approximate dates of June 15 and September 15 of each calendar year.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that its principal operations are conducted within Lassen Volcanic National Park; that during the winter season the roads of said park become impassable by reason of heavy snow falls and that no provisions are maintained by the park authorities to keep the roadways clear for operation of automotive equipment thereover.

This is not a matter requiring a public hearing and the request appearing to be in the public interest will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operations of applicant authorized by Decision No. 28607 dated March 2, 1936 shall be conducted hereafter on a seasonal basis between the approximate dates of June 15 and September 15 of each calendar year, subject to the condition that applicant shall immediately prepare and file a time schedule giving effect to the restriction herein granted.
