In the Matter of the Application of PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY for authority to construct a double spur track at grade across portion of Aliso Street in the City of Los Angeles.

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct three spur tracks at grade across the northern roadway of Aliso Street in the City of Los Angeles, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as crossing No. 6P-1.18-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent. Protection shall be by a member of the train crew or other competent employee acting as flagman. Applicant shall, within ninety days, submit a certified copy of a franchise or permit from the City of Los Angeles for the construction of said crossing at grade.

Within thirty days after the completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended) or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
