O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Carbon for more than two (2) years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary. It further appears that a spur track, located at said station has not been used for the receipt or delivery of freight for several years and that continued maintenance of such is unnecessary.

Good cause appearing, the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Carbon, County of Mendocino; to eliminate said name from its station records; to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station; and to remove said spur track located at said station on one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
