O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Union Mills for more than 2 years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency state of Union Mills, County of Nevada, State of California, and to abandon and remove its shelter shed located at said Station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
