BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, by condemnation proceedings, have acquired the right of way of Pacific Electric Railway Company's alternate line of railroad between Hawthorne and a point near El Nido in Los Angeles County. No passenger service has been handled on this line since October 16th, 1933, and the only service of any character rendered has been a box motor operated once daily, except Sundays and holidays, in one direction only, between Redondo Beach and El Segundo.

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to abandon and remove its alternate line of railroad between Hawthorne and a point near El Nido, as more particularly described in the application and as shown in yellow on the map (C.E.H. 16033), attached thereto.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended). This order shall be effective immediately.
