O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Rugg, Fresno County, for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Rugg, County of Fresno, and to abandon and remove its shelter shed at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
