ORDER VACATING ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING

By an order dated October 24, 1938, the above entitled proceeding was reopened for the purpose of receiving evidence concurrently with the receipt of evidence in Application No. 22303, in which the California Portland Cement Company sought a reduction in the minimum rate established for the transportation of shale in dump trucks from a shale deposit near Pomona to the cement mill of that company near Colton.

Subsequently, Application No. 22303 was dismissed at applicant's request. The cause for reopening the above entitled proceeding having thus been removed, the order dated October 24, 1938, will be vacated and set aside.
