FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION

By this supplemental application Natalie Bacci, operating under the name and style of Cloverdale - Geysers Stage Line, seeks authority to continue the suspension of his automotive service for the transportation of passengers as a common carrier between Cloverdale and The Geysers and intermediate points heretofore authorized by Decision No. 30920, dated May 31, 1938.

Applicant alleges as justification for the authority sought that the hotel at The Geysers, recently destroyed by fire, has not been rebuilt and, as a consequence thereof, there is no present need for a common carrier service.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OKDER

IT IS ORDERED that Natalie Bacci, operating under the name and style of Cloverdale - Geysers Stage Line, is hereby authorized to continue the temporary suspension of his automotive service for the

transportation of passengers as a common carrier between Cloverdale and "No Geysers and intermediate points until June 1, 1939, provided that on or before such date applicant shall either resume service or relinquish his operating right therefor, and provided further that he shall immediately file and make effective on five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public a supplement to his tariffs and a time schedule showing the suspension as herein authorized.
