O R D E R

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Topham Street in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BY-450-71-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G. O. No. 75-A).

Applicant shall file with the Commission, within a period of sixty (60) days from the date hereof, a certified copy of a franchise or permit from the City of Los Angeles approving construction of said crossing, and in the event said franchise or permit is not filed, the authority herein granted shall become null and void.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
