O R D E R

Ora B. Heple, owner of Heple Transportation Company, on or about June 3, 1937, purchased certain bus equipment from Patchette & Carstensen, Inc., under a contract requiring applicant to pay \$2,040.00 in cash, the payment of eleven monthly installments of \$137.96 each, and a further payment of \$3,448.94. At the time the contract was signed, Patchette & Carstensen, Inc., agreed that they would allow her to pay said \$3,448.94 in monthly installments of \$137.96 each. It is of record that Patchette & Carstensen, Inc., has assigned the contract to the Pacific National Bank of San Francisco. Applicant reports that she has made a payment of \$137.96 on the \$3,448.94 and that she is unable to pay at this time the balance of \$3,310.98 and that all parties have agreed to amend and renew the contract to cover the payment of said balance of \$3,310.98 in monthly installments of \$137.96.

The Commission has considered applicant's request and is of the opinion that this is not a matter on which a hearing is necessary, and that this application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ora B. Heple, owner of Heple Transportation Company, be, and she is, hereby authorized to amend and renew, after the effective date of this order and prior to February 1,

1939, the contract referred to in her petition and in this order so as to provide for the payment of the said \$3,310.98 in twenty-four monthly installments of \$137.96 each.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that within thirty (30) days after the execution of the amendment and renewal of said contract, Ora B. Heple, owner of Heple Transportation Company, shall file with the Commission a copy of said contract.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted will become effective when Ora B. Heple, owner of Heple Transportation Company, has paid the minimum fee provided by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which minimum fee is twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).
