In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the construction of crossings at separated grades of the State highway and the tracks of the Union Pacific and Southern Pacific Railroads, one mile west of Pomona, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct State Highway Route 77 (Road VII-LA-77-B), at separated grades over the main line track of Southern Pacific Company, to be identified as Crossing No. B-512.4-A, and to reconstruct an existing separation of this same highway over the main line track of the Union Pacific Railroad Company near Pomona, Los Angeles County, to be identified as Crossing No. 3-30.0-A, both at the locations as shown by the map (Exhibit "A"), attached to the application.

Applicant shall bear construction and maintenance expense. Applicant shall file with the Commission, within one hundred twenty (120) days - (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to construction, reconstruction and maintenance of said crossings; and (2) plans of said crossings approved by Southern Pacific Company and the Union Pacific Railroad Company. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-C. During construction, only, overhead clearances of 19' 6" and horizontal clearances of 8' may be maintained, provided that - (1) train speeds do not exceed twenty miles per hour; (2) train crews are notified by

bulletin or train order of said impaired clearances; and(3) telltales are maintained on each side of said structure during the period of said impaired clearances.

Upon completion, Crossing No. E-511-8, about 3000 feet west, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty (30) days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
