O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Hammond for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary. It further appears that there is located at said station a spur track approximately 531 feet in length which has not been used by the public either for passenger service or for the receipt or delivery of freight for several years.

Good cause appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Hammond, County of Humboldt; to eliminate said name from its station records; to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station; and to abandon and remove the spur track located at said station on one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
