SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By supplemental application R. G. Knoll, Inc., Ltd., a highway contract carrier, seeks a one year extension of the authority granted it by Decision No. 30377 of December 6, 1937, in the above entitled application, (as amended by Decision No. 30982 of June 13, 1938), to transport sugar from Los Angeles and Long Beach Harbors to Los Angeles, Glendale, Pasadena and Santa Ana, for California-Hawaiian Sugar Refining Corporation, Ltd., at rates less than the minimum rates established for such transportation by Decision No. 29480, as amended, in Case No. 4088, Part "M".

In support of the supplemental application it is alleged that the conditions existing at the time Decisions Nos. 30377 and 30982, supra, were issued still exist to the same extent, and in the same degree and manner; that no new conditions have since arisen, and that, therefore, the need for an extension of the relief granted by the said decisions is now as acute as at the time the authority was first sought. All parties of record in this proceeding have advised the Commission that they have no objections to the extension of the original authority for a further one year period.

This is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary. The supplemental application will be granted. Therefore, good

cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that R. G. Knoll, Inc., Ltd., be and it is hereby authorized to assess and collect rates less than those established by Decision No. 29480, as amended, in Case No. 4082, Part "M", but not less than the rates set forth in Appendix "A" of Decision No. 30377, dated December 6, 1937, as amended by Decision No. 30982 of June 13, 1938, for the transportation of sugar for California-Hawaiian Sugar Refining Corporation, Ltd., between the points specified in said Appendix "A".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall expire December 26, 1939, unless sooner changed, cancelled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective December 26, 1938.
