O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Vigorit for more than two years and that its continued maintenance as a freight station is no longer necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to change its Class "A" non-agency station of Vigorit, County of Alameda, to a Class "E" station, and to cancel all freight tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Within thirty days thereafter applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
