FIFTEENTH SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 3/605 or Dec. 27, 1938, in Case No. 4088, Part "N", Case No. 4145 and Case No. 4246, a revised basis for computing highway mileages was prescribed for use in applying minimum rates stated in mileage scale form. Effective Feoruary 15,1939, that decision cancels and supersedes Decision No. 30000, as amended, in Part "N" of Case No. 4088, which decision now provides the mileage casis by which the minimum rates provided by Decision No. 30085 of August 28, 1937, as amended, in the above entitled proceedings for the transportation of refined petroleum and petroleum products, are now governed. Said Decision No. 30085 will therefore be further amended to provide that the mileage rates therein established will be subject to the new basis for computing highway mileages.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that reference to Decision No. 30000 of August 9, 1937, in Case No. 4088, Part "N", be deleted from paragraph (c) and paragraph (c)l of Rule No. 60 of Appendix "A-l" of Decision No. 30085 of August 28, 1937, in the above entitled proceedings, and that reference to Decision No. 31605, of Dec. 27, 1938, in Case No. 4088, Part "N", Case No. 4145 and Case No. 4246, be substituted therefor.

In all other respects said Decision No. 20085, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective February 15,1939.
