BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

It appears from the above application that the easement held by Pacific Electric Railway Company, colored red on the map (Drawing C.E.H.-16084), attached to the application, is no longer necessary for railroad purposes and that the relocation of Pacific Electric Railway Company's passenger car storage facilities will not inconvenience the passenger or shipping public.

Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to convey to the Fernando Valley Milling and Supply Company and Southern Pacific Railroad Company, substantially in accordance with the terms proposed in the application, those certain parcels of property as fully described in the application and as shown by the map (Drawing C.E.H.-16084, attached thereto.

Within thirty days after the transfer, applicant shall file with this Commission a certified copy of the indenture. This authority shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with.
