In the matter of the Application of Sonoma County, acting through its Board of Supervisors, for permission to construct King Street at grade across the Northwestern Pacific Railroad.

ORDER

Sonoma County is authorized to construct at grade King Street across the tracks of the Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company near Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 5-55.8-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall beer maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 36 feet and grades of approach not greater than five per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing sigms. (G.O. 75-A).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
