OPINION AND ORDER

By this application Edward Malde, doing business as A B C Transfer & Storage Company, seeks authority to transport household goods, furniture and personal effects, and to perform certain accessorial services in connection therewith, under a contract with the United States Navy Department expiring June 30, 1939, at rates less than those established by Decision No. 28810, as amended, in Case No. 4086. In support of the application it is alleged that the revenue which would accrue under the proposed rates would aggregate as much as, if not more than, the revenue which would accrue under the established minimum rates. It is alleged, further, that the proposed rates are identical with those heretofore authorized by the Commission in Decision No. 31089, dated July 5, 1938, in Application No. 22057, in connection with a similar contract with the Navy Department which terminated December 31, 1938.

It appears from the application that the rates proposed are the same as those heretofore authorized by Decision No. 31089, supra, and that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary. The application will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and it is hereby granted.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall expire July 1, 1939, unless sooner changed, cancelled or extended by appropriate order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
