BY THE COMMISSION:

O P I N I O N

A. H. Weston, applicant herein, operating under the name and style of Woodland-Rumsey Auto Stage, is operating as an automotive common carrier of passengers, baggage and express, between Woodland and Rumsey and certain intermediate points by virtue of authority granted by this Commission's Decision No. 10451, dated May 12, 1922, in Application No. 7557. In the transportation of express applicant is now restricted to transporting packages weighing not in excess of fifty (50) pounds.

By this application A. H. Weston requests that his certificate of public convenience and necessity be amended to provide the further restriction that he be not required to transport single express shipments in excess of one hundred (100) pounds.

Applicant alleges that his actual express operations consist of the handling of property within the weight limits referred to above and that the granting of the authority sought will materially aid him in complying with the various rate orders of this Commission by enabling him to avoid the expense of filing amended express tariffs for shipments over one hundred (100) pounds. Applicant has applied for and been granted exemption from the aforementioned rate order with respect to shipments of one hundred (100) pounds, or less.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 10451, dated May 12, 1922, in Application No. 7557, be and it is hereby amended by the insertion therein of the following restriction:

In the transportation of express no single shipment in excess of one hundred (100) pounds shall be transported,

subject to the condition that,

Applicant shall file in triplicate and on at least ten (10) days' notice to the Commission and the public a tariff or tariffs in conformity with the authority herein granted.

In all other respects Decision No. 10451 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
