FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, party at interest in this matter,
having requested in writing that Decision No. 31493, dated November
28, 1938, which authorized the construction of Calaveras Avenue at
grade over the tracks of said company, near Coalinga, be modified in
order to relieve said company of bearing the cost of preparing the
tracks to receive the pavement and, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the words commencing in line seven
(7) and ending in line eight (8) of Decision No. 31493, and reading
"shall bear the cost of preparing its tracks to receive the pavement
and" are hereby rescinded and of no further force and effect.

In all other respects said Decision No. 31493 shall remain
in full force and effect. This order shall become effective immediately.
